
School rules

1. Children must be in school between 8.45am - **9.15am**

2. Children must go to school every day.

3. If your child is not at school you must telephone or email to the school.

4. If you want to take your child out of school you must telephone or email



5. Give the teacher names of adults who come to the school to collect children.




6. Put your child's name on bags and clothes.



7. Children have homework on 4 nights:

Monday, Tuesday Wednesday Thursday



8.00am

Glencull's 'Breakfast club' is from 8.00 am to 8.45am during term time, Monday to Friday. It is open to children of school going age. The children have the opportunity to use the school's ICT equipment, outdoor play equipment and sporting facilities first thing in the morning.

The children get a healthy breakfast when they arrive and get a chance to relax before a hard day's work.

If a family wishes to use the service they are required to commit to using the service for a full year, a minimum of 3 days a week. The service costs £2.00 per day (for your first child, every subsequent child is £1) covering the cost of employment of staff, food and equipment. The initiative is none profit.

BREAKFAST CLUB





Children in Primary 1 and 2 in other primary schools like to go home at 2 o'clock, but the children at St. Malachy's would rather stay all day! St. Malachy's primary school Glencull offers primary 1 and 2 children the opportunity to stay at "The TUI Club" from 2 o'clock (the normal home time for this age group) until 3.15 in the afternoon.

Mrs Mallon and Mrs Quinlivan plan play based activities for the children, including; art and crafts, computer club, fit club and big book club. But this only takes place after they have a snack to keep their energy up after a hard morning's work in Mrs. Mc Kenna and Mrs Harte's room. This year we have started the Employers For Childcare Vouchers scheme with both breakfast and TUI clubs. Childcare Vouchers are available to all working parents. They can help each parent make up to £933 of tax and National Insurance savings per year on their childcare costs, until their child is 15. The scheme is implemented through your employer's payroll via a 'salary sacrifice' scheme, which means you swap part of your salary to pay for childcare. Visit www.employersforchildcare.org
