will also send home a copy of the music from the KS2 show via What's app for each family to practice. This will give each child some rehearsal time at home. Click the picture of the tickets to book a seat!




Really Big Draw!

Adverse Weather: Action Plan

As was the case in January 2015, adverse weather conditions can hinder the smooth operation of day to day activities in school. In January 2015 we were forced to have an exceptional closure due to the kitchen at St Mary's being closed (which supplies our meals). To avoid this happening this winter the Board of Governors have put in place the following contingency plan.

In the event of adverse weather e.g. closing the meals kitchen, the school will send a text message by 8.15am to allow parents to prepare a packed lunch for the day ahead.



New P1 2024

If your child was born between 2 July 2018 and 1 July 2019, they will be due to start primary one in September 2024, and as they will be of compulsory school age, you must apply for a place in a primary school.

If your child is starting pre-school or primary school in September 2024, you can apply for their place online from Tuesday 09 January 2024 - 12 noon. The portal closes Friday 26 January 2024 - 12 noon .

Christmas Choir


Fr O'Dwyer invites the p7 confirmation class to sing at Sounds of the season:
