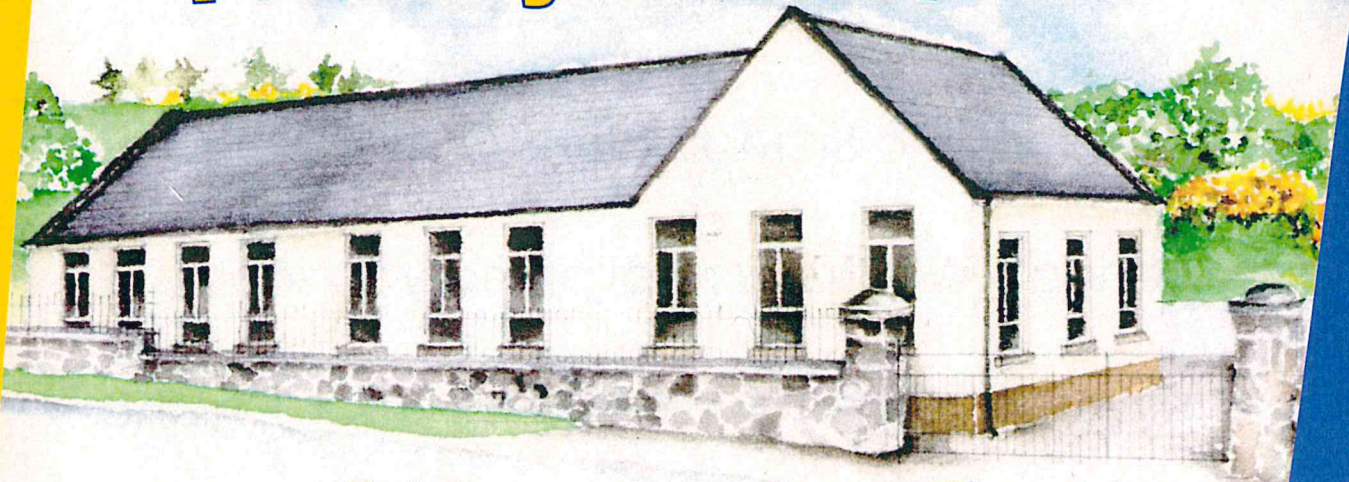

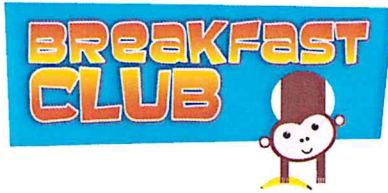
Welcome

Glencull's unique 'Breakfast club' is from 8.00 am to 8.45am during term time, Monday to Friday. It is open to children of school going age. The children have the opportunity to use the school's ICT equipment, outdoor play equipment and sporting facilities first thing in the morning.

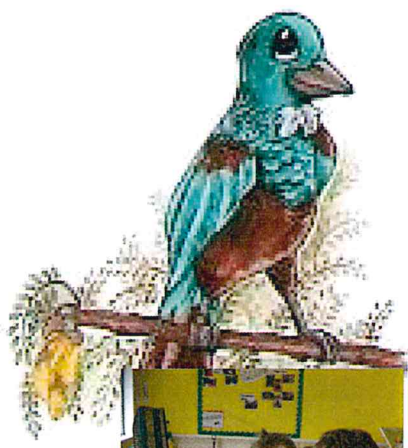
The children get a healthy breakfast when they arrive and get a chance to relax before a hard day's work.

If a family wishes to use the service they are required to commit to using the service for a full year, a minimum of 3 days a week. The service costs £1.80 per child per day covering the cost of employment of staff, food and equipment. The initiative is none profit.

St. Malachy's primary school Glencull offers primary 1 and 2 children the opportunity to stay at "The TUI Club" from 2 o'clock (the normal home time for this age group) until 3.15 in the afternoon.
