

# Walk to School

Monday 16th May will be an Active travel day at St Malachy's. We will encourage the children to get dropped off at St Malachy's Church and walk around the path or 'pad' to school.

According to 'Sustrans'; The school journey is a perfect opportunity for children to learn about their local area, develop wider social networks and gain independence.

The average primary school journey is just 1.6 miles, and yet one in four cars on the road during the morning peak are doing the school run. Encouraging children to walk will reduce congestion and pollution around the school gates. It will also help your child's mental and physical health.



## End of Year Tests

At this time of year the whole school sit their end of year tests. From Tuesday 3rd until the Middle of June Primary 2-7 pupils will be given Numeracy and Literacy tests to track their progress and to highlight what great work they have been doing all year. Attendance and punctuality are important during this time as we hope to give everyone the best possible chance of performing well. Please encourage your child to read questions slowly and a second and third time. Why not ask some quick numeracy questions on a long car journey. Every little bit of practice helps.
